To receive an incentive, the customer must follow Duke Energy's requirements as stated on the Window Checklist on the back of this form.

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CUSTOMER REQUIREMENTS

- Customer must have received a recommendation from a Duke Energy Home Energy Check advisor within the past two years and prior to installation.
- Residence must be in a Duke Energy service area and a residential metered customer. Must reside in single-family home.
- New construction homes do not qualify.
- Residence must have whole-house electric heating and air conditioning.
- For incentive payment, the customer shall have six months from the installation date to submit the following documentation by email or U.S. mail to Duke Energy:
 - 1. Window incentive form completed, signed and dated
 - 2. Contractor invoice
 - 3. Copy of the NFRC label off one of the windows (or one for each different type of window) or other supporting documentation from the manufacturer
- Customer will allow a Duke Energy Program Inspector access to premises if the home is selected for an inspection. After the inspection has been successfully completed, the incentive payment will be processed.
- The incentive payment will be credited to the customer's bill.
- A partial window replacement is acceptable.



INCENTIVE

\$2 per square foot of window area up to a **maximum of \$400**

CONTRACTOR REQUIREMENTS

- Contractor is responsible for the work to be performed, for supervision of their employees and for using their own equipment. The contractor must comply with all federal, state and local codes and regulations and have the appropriate license(s) and insurance(s) for the work to be performed. If requested, insurance(s) must be made available to Duke Energy.
- Contractor or customer must complete the contractor portion of the Duke Energy Window Incentive Form.
- Contractor must meet all manufacturer's installation instructions and specifications.
- Contractor shall indemnify, defend and hold Duke Energy harmless for any injuries, damages, claims or costs caused by items furnished or services rendered.
- Window must be labeled by the NFRC for achieving a Solar Heat Gain Coefficient (SHGC) of ≤ 0.25 and a U-value of ≤ 0.35 . If the window is not NFRC labeled, the manufacturer may provide documentation supporting that the window meets these values.
- Contractor must leave a copy of the manufacturer's product specification sheet and the invoice with the customer.
- A partial window replacement is acceptable.
- All materials shall be new and not refurbished, previously installed or used.
